



History of Old Apex Town Hall

Built in 1912 at the cost of \$7,500, the building was used as a multi-purpose building and housed town government for 65 years. Originally, the first floor was a fresh meat and vegetable market, a small fire house, and a jail.

The second floor included the Mayor's office and a theatre that seated three hundred. Today, older residents talk of the entertainment that was held at the Town Hall such as silent movies, dramas, musicals and Chautauquas (tent shows).

Directions

From US 1 South—Turn @ Exit 96

- Turn left at Ten Ten Rd/Center Street.
- Center St. dead ends at the Halle Cultural Arts Center, 237 N. Salem Street.

From US 64 West—Turn @ Downtown Apex Exit

- Turn left onto N Salem St. at stop sign.
- Turn left at stoplight onto N Salem St.
- Follow N Salem St. into Historic Downtown Apex.
- The Halle Cultural Arts Center of Apex is on the right at 237 N. Salem. Parking in rear.

From Hwy 55 S—Turn left @ stoplight onto Hunter St.

- Turn right at stoplight onto Salem St.
- Turn right at Templeton St. at Halle Cultural Arts Center. Parking in rear.

It also has two galleries with constantly changing exhibits. The versatility of the studios provide for multiple uses, both in classes and public rentals.
